

## Remembering the fallen

SECOND World War veteran Ian Forsyth stands next to an artwork representing the last tree on a First World War battlefield that has just gone on display at the People's Palace in Glasgow.

The 6ft sculpture, France 1914, has been made out of Italian marble by Simon Burns-Cox, depicting a symbol of hope and survival.

It has been loaned to Glasgow Museums in support of Poppy Scotland and will also be exhibited at Kelvingrove and the Riverside Museum at later dates.
